

## Roseville High School Student Conduct Policy

**Roseville High School Student Conduct** (page 8 of student planner): Students will be reviewed in the areas of **academics, behavior, and attendance**. Failure to meet appropriate standards in any one of these areas will result in loss of privileges including extra-curricular activities and/or graduation.

If a Student is on **Student Conduct for Academics, Attendance, or Discipline** at the time of any student activity, that student will not be allowed to attend and participate in that activity.

### Common Questions:

#### STUDENT CONDUCT FOR ACADEMICS Q & A:

- ◆ Received an "F" in any course at the conclusion of a quarter grading period (final grade).

Q: Does it count if I don't need the class for graduation?

A: YES

Q: Do I have to appeal?

A: Yes, if there is an upcoming event before the next grading period you plan to attend.

A: Maybe not. If you are passing all of your classes at the completion of the next grading period you will earn your way off student conduct.

Q: If I earn my way off of Student Conduct is it possible to go back on?

A: Yes. This applies to all final grading periods.

Q: What if I do not appeal and my grades stay the same?

A: You will not be eligible to participate in Student activities.

#### STUDENT CONDUCT FOR ATTENDANCE Q & A:

- ◆ Attendance record with 20 or more period absences during any quarter grading period.

Q: Does attendance start over at the grading period?

A: Yes, but students will remain on Student Conduct until their attendance has noticeably improved as reviewed during the upcoming grading period

Q: Do "excused" or "illness" absences count?

A: Yes. All absences count because all absence may negatively impact your learning and progress in class.

Q: Do I have to appeal?

A: Yes, if there is an upcoming event before the next grading period.

A: Maybe not. If your attendance has improved better than 16 period absences at the completion of the next grading period you will earn your way off student conduct.

**STUDENT CONDUCT FOR DISCIPLINE Q & A:**

- ◆ Any suspension from school for any offense during the school year.

Q: Do I have to appeal?

A: Students must appeal if placed on Student Conduct for Discipline.

Any Student who has been placed on Student Conduct and removed from school activities may appeal that decision to their Assistant Principal.

**APPEAL Q & A:**

Q: How do I appeal?

A: Students appealing for Attendance, Grades, and Discipline may submit a written appeal. Appeal forms are available in the Assistant Principal's office.

A: Appeals must be submitted prior to the final day of Student Conduct Committee dates. Parents are welcome to attend, but are not required.

Q: If my appeal is approved and go back onto Student Conduct at the end of the next quarter, do I have to appeal again?

A: Yes or you may wait and earn your way off at the next grading period.

Q: What if I miss my appeal date?

A: You will remain on Student Conduct until the next grading period.

Q: Do my parents have to attend?

A: No. Parents are welcome but not required to attend.
