Annual CAHSEE Notification, School Year 2011-2012

Dear Parents or Guardians,

All students in California public schools are required to pass the California High School Exit Examination (CAHSEE) to receive a high school diploma. This graduation requirement is mandated by state law. The purpose of the CAHSEE is to improve student achievement in high school and ensure that students who graduate from high school can demonstrate competency in the state academic content standards for reading, writing, and mathematics.

Testing dates for the CAHSEE are designated each year by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction. The table below lists the months for testing administration and the students that may be tested for each administration of the CAHSEE. Tenth Grade students will be scheduled to take the exam once during their tenth grade year in February or March. If they are absent in February or March, a make-up administration will be offered in May. Students who did not pass or take the exam in the tenth grade will have five additional testing opportunities, twice during their junior and three times during their senior year. Students will receive additional instruction, if needed, to ensure success on this exam.

The district will continue to keep parents and students informed about this important examination.
